If you or someone you know may need some extra support if COVID-19 arrives in the Yukon, please contact KFN staff listed below so we can include you on a list for support. In particular, we are focusing on Citizens who have minimal family or other support.

DO YOU KNOW

Anyone who is:

- an older adult
- at risk due to underlying medical conditions (e.g. heart disease, hypertension, diabetes, chronic respiratory diseases, asthma, COPD, cancer, sleep apnea)
- at risk due to a compromised immune system from a medical condition or treatment (e.g. chemotherapy)

Anyone who has:

- difficulty reading, speaking, understanding or communicating
- difficulty accessing medical care or health advice
- difficulty doing preventive activities, like frequent hand washing and covering coughs and sneezes
- ongoing specialized medical care or needs specific medical supplies
- ongoing supervision needs or support for maintaining independence
- difficulty accessing transportation
- economic barriers
- unstable employment or inflexible working conditions
- social or geographic isolation, like in remote and isolated communities
- insecure, inadequate, or nonexistent housing conditions
