COVID 19 SAFETY RESTRICTIONS

1. Temperature checks for assigned groupings of incoming participants
 - a. Community Nurse will conduct the temperature checks
 - b. Participants with above-normal temperatures will be asked to leave
 - c. Participant(s) showing symptoms must leave the camp: fever, chills, cough, chest pain

2. If a participant is in contact with any of the Yukon's Covid 19 cases (ie. Whitehorse or Dawson), you should not attend this event

3. A self-assessment tool is available for participants prior to camp attendance

4. Face masks:
 - a. Optional use

5. Disposable gloves
 - a. Optional use
 - b. Must use during handling of wild meats or fish

6. Hand sanitizers will be set up outside the tent activity

7. This camp is a public event and 35 participants can enter daily
 - a. With Camp staff and sessional instructors included, number of individuals cannot exceed 50 people
 - b. Incoming participants must check in before entering the site

8. To ensure safety of participants and KFN citizens/staff, family groups will move from one activity to another

9. Families will be assigned group seating for meals or breaks
10. Family groupings will move from one activity to another
11. Activity tents and tables will be spaced 6' apart
12. Large tent activities will be located near entrances
 - a. 2 activities at a time with 6' spacing
13. Meals will be packaged and handed out to participants
 - a. Bring a coffee mug and utensils
14. If camping or parking a trailer, you are responsible for following Safe-6 restrictions
15. **NOTE:** Registration is required for this event due to global pandemic
16. Kluane First Nation is required to follow Dr. Hanley's advice for Safe-6
